You recently had Swingle plant a new tree or shrub on your property.

As of October 24th, Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Denver, Douglas, Jefferson, Larimer and Weld counties have only seen an average of .41" of water in the last 30 days.

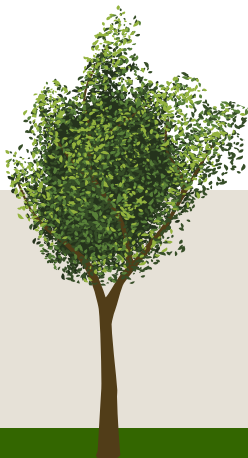
- Tree root growth occurs in fall and winter months when days are shorter
- Without sufficient watering, tree roots will not grow as needed
- The worst scenario for your tree is to allow the soil to freeze dry

Your trees (especially newly planted trees) should be watered every three to four weeks throughout the fall and winter months. If not properly watered, they may experience irreparable damage - compromising the survival of the tree.

If you can't provide adequate watering, Swingle offers a supplemental watering program. Our ReCharge™ service is designed for deep root watering. A soil injection application, it combines Yuccah and water – breaking the surface tension and allowing water to percolate easier through the soil.

On average: 10" of snow only equals about 1" of water. Trees and shrubs need 3-4" every 30 days.
